Award of Riverfront Amphitheater Phase I Bid

City of Selma Project

WHEREAS, the City of Selma published an advertisement for bids in the Selma Times Journal to receive bids for work to be done at the Riverfront Warehouse for Phase I of the Selma Riverfront Amphitheater; *and*

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received by the City of Selma at Selma City Hall, 222 Broad Street, Selma from the time solicited and closed at 2:00 pm on January 23, 2012, at which time the bids received were opened and read aloud; *and*

WHEREAS, the appropriate officials of the City and the project engineer, Davis Architect, tabulated the bids and determined Frasier-Ousley Construction and Engineering, Inc. to be the lowest responsible bidder, said bids were certified by Davis Architect; *and*

WHEREAS, the City desired to do value engineering to further reduce the cost of the contract; *and*

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to award Frasier-Ousley Construction and Engineering, Inc. a contract in the amount of \$597,800.00 for Phase I of the Selma Riverfront Amphitheater; *and*


WHEREAS, it is desired that said contract expenses be encumbered via the Bond and ADECA-CDBG reimbursable funds.


