

**RESOLUTION

North Church Street Sewer Blockage

WHEREAS, according to an onsite evaluation by Mr. Tommy Smith, Director of Public Works and the professional assessment of Hogg Engineering Corporation, it appears to be a major blockage in the existing 8-inch gravity sewer main causing an extensive back-up of sewage, including on Second Avenue between North Church and North Lauderdale Street; *and*

WHEREAS, Public Works has made numerous attempts to unstop the but have not been successful. City crews are having to by-pass pump the sewage on a weekly basis and residents have complained about the sewage backups; and

WHEREAS, Hogg Engineering Corporation estimates that it will cost approximately \$78,200.00 for replacing this section of pipe and \$11,730.00 for Professional and Engineering Inspection fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama as follows:

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to proceed with obtaining bids for the replacement of the existing 8-inch gravity sewer main in question, including entering into a contract with Hogg Engineering Corporation for Professional Engineering and Inspection services.
